Hard hats to BHS Specification MUST be worn at all times whilst mounted. FOREIGN BREEDS: IF YOU WEAR TRADITIONAL DRESS YOU MUST SIGN A DISCLAIMER.

Correct rider dress is expected in showing, jumping & dressage rings.

The committee reserve the right to cancel, add to or alter any class they see fit. Classes may be split or combined if entries warrant it.

It is the competitors responsibility to present themselves at the correct time for their class.

STALLIONS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED BY PRIOR AGREEMENT WITH THE SHOW SECRETARY AND MUST BE BITTED AT ALL TIMES

No refund of entry fees – Unless supported by a valid Veterinary certificate.

Objections to be made to the secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the end of the class and accompanied by a £10 deposit.

Dogs to be kept on a lead at all times.

Competitors are requested not to leave litter or muck out horse boxes on the showground.

No galloping outside the rings.

All ridden horses/ponies must be four years or over.

All persons attending the show will be deemed to have accepted the rules and conditions.
