**We reserve the right to run any test on either a surface or grass. Please note that the Lincoln championships will all be on grass. If possible, all tests will be run on a surface, should numbers dictate that we need to use an additional grass arena(s), clubs will be notified as soon as possible.**

### **Area Entries**

Area entries will be via [www.equoEvents.co.uk](http://www.equoEvents.co.uk). If you are unable to complete your entry via EquoEvents, then we may be able to accept your entry by post with an additional £5 charge. Please state your riding club in the 'notes' section of your entry, and whether you are in a team or an individual. Team Managers – Teams and individuals must be confirmed by Tuesday 18th July. Please do not send in too early to keep changes to a minimum.

### **Entries Close at Midnight 18<sup>th</sup> July 2021**

Late entries will only be accepted if numbers allow. The organiser reserves the right to close entries early if necessary.

### **Preliminary Entries**

These must be made to British Riding Clubs Office by Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> July 2021 (21 days before this competition) online via [brc.bhs.org.uk](http://brc.bhs.org.uk).

**Times:** Will be posted on the Brent Knoll Riding Club's web site [www.bkrc.co.uk](http://www.bkrc.co.uk) on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> July after 8pm.

### **Withdrawals**

These will be refunded via EquoEvents, incurring a £5.00 admin fee to cover the costs incurred with Equo and Stripe, providing they are received before the closing date. You will not be refunded the £1.50 fee Equo charge for each transaction.

**Substitutions:** In the event of withdrawals after the closing date, substitutions will be allowed up until 2pm on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> July. Please **EMAIL** all changes to [BKRCdressage@gmail.com](mailto:BKRCdressage@gmail.com).

Last minute simple substitutions may be made at the time teams are declared. Simple substitutions are ones where another horse and/or rider replaces the withdrawn one in the same team and position.

**Declarations:** Must be made by Team Manager 30 minutes before the start of the class on Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> July 2021 or can be emailed by 6pm on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> July to [BKRCdressage@gmail.com](mailto:BKRCdressage@gmail.com).

**Declarations must be in a PDF or Excel format (please no photographs/screenshots). Any prelim entry that does not submit their declaration before 30 minutes of the start of the class will not be eligible to qualify.**

### **SWWRC - South Wales & West of England Riding Club Championships**

This is taking place at Hartpury on Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2021. This is a Championships for teams from BRC clubs in Areas 9, 12, 15, 18 and 19 competing in Riding Test, Prelim Dressage, Style Jumping and 80cm Show Jumping. To qualify you do not need to have BRC prelim entries.

## Insurance

All Riding Club Members are covered by third party insurance. Anyone attending the event that is **NOT** a riding club member should have their own Third Party Liability Insurance. Brent Knoll Riding Club strongly recommends that all Riding Club Members hold their own Personal Accident insurance in addition to the insurance cover provided by their BRC members.

## RULES

- This competition will be run in accordance with the Riding Club Rules for Competitions 2021, and the current COVID regulations. Due to ongoing COVID-19 restrictions and possible changes in government guidance, it may be necessary to amend how this event is run at a late stage. Any Covid Restrictions will be posted on our website prior to the event, and by entering this event you agree to abide by any measure we may have to implement at a late stage.
- Entry is open to all members of affiliated Riding clubs in Area 12. Only competitors are permitted to ride horses on the showground.
- The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate, split or amend classes as required. Classes may be run in different order to the schedule and be on grass or a surface.
- The Judge's decision is final.
- Any objections must be handed to the Official Steward no later than 30 minutes after the incident, 30 minutes after the results have been published, or in the case of a protest against qualification of horse/rider, 60 minutes after the start of the class. They must be lodged in writing, with a £20 deposit as per the BRC handbook.
- British Riding Clubs, Kings Sedgemoor Equestrian Centre and persons acting on their behalf, do not accept any liability for any loss, accident, or damage to any person, animal, vehicle or goods occurring in connection with this event. It is a condition of entry that each competitor indemnifies the organiser against any claim.
- Flu Vaccinations. Your horse must have up to date influenza vaccinations in line with rule G7 in the current BRC Handbook. This includes the 6 months rule.
- Rider/bridle numbers must be displayed on both sides of the horse at all times.
- Protective headwear must be worn at all times by anyone riding anywhere at a BRC event. Harnesses must be correctly adjusted and fastened. Protective Headwear constitutes a hat which meets one of the following standards. Failure to do so will incur elimination.

British	PAS 015: 1998 or 2011 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked
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European	VG1 01.040: 2014-12 provided they are BSI Kitemarked or Inspec IC marked
American	ASTM F1163: 2004a or 04a onwards provided they are SEI marked SNELL E2001 or SNELL E2016
Australian and NZ	AS/NZS 3838: 2006 onwards provided they are SAI global marked

- Hats will be checked and tagged at this competition. Please allow extra time for this process.
- Competitors must report to the steward and be ready to ride their test at least 10 minutes before their allotted time. Warm up times will also be given.
- Horses Passport/Vaccination Certificate must, under penalty of elimination, accompany the horse to all official competitions, the competitor is responsible for producing it on demand. As of 1 October 2020, it is compulsory for all horses to be microchipped. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure the horse is chipped and it is traceable.
- HEALTH AND SAFETY. The organisers and landowners have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must obey the instructions of the Organisers, Officials and Stewards and take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring. First Aid cover will be provided.
- Horses or ponies should not be left tied up outside horseboxes or trailers or left unattended.

**PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR HORSE AND TAKE ALL YOUR LITTER HOME**

- All dogs must be on leads, and under control at all times.
