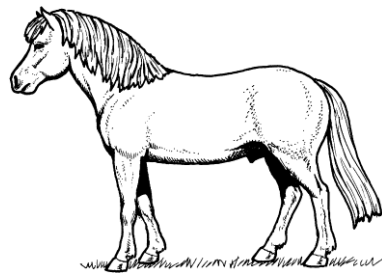

No cantering or galloping in the parking areas.

Horses & ponies must not be left unattended when tied outside to lorry/trailer.

Dogs to be kept on leads at all times.

All children must be supervised at all times.

SOUTH WEST PONY ASSOCIATION CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFYING

RULES

This show is a qualifier for the South West Pony Association Championships to be held
on 30th August – 2nd September 2018

At The David Broom Centre, Crick, Monmouthshire. NP26 5XP

To qualify for the Championships:

1. Enter one of the qualifying classes
2. Be one of the TWO highest placed exhibits not already qualified within the first four and receive a qualification card signed in the ring
3. Complete the entry form on the qualification card
4. Return the card together with any **registration fees due within 14 days of this show**

TSR QUALIFYING RULES

TSR SHOWING FINALS – This show is a qualifier for the 2018 TSR Regional Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Regional Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish

You do not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse or pony in any number of Finals

TSR Rider Finals – 1st and 2nd placed riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring

TSR In Hand Finals – The two highest placed handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any in hand classes. Handlers **MUST** have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available free from the TSR website.
