

This new end of season Champion of Champion event will give many young and aspiring equestrians something to aim for and to represent the club which they ride for. What a true honour!

It is anticipated that the event will grow in future years — maybe even hold regional events. Sarah believes this event will bring together the best of the best who will go head-to-head to be crowned Champion. With the chance to win not only the joy of victory for individual riders, but also financial reward and prestige of being crowned the STARS Supreme Riding Club of the year. This will be done in such a manner as to make it fair whether you represent a large or smaller club — the top ten results from each season will be used and toiled to bring you your eventual champion.

This year Stars are holding their first southern championship at Addington Manor Buckinghamshire.

Rules to take part: you must be a member of Brent Knoll Riding Club.

The show secretary will keep a record of your points you are awarded each time u get placed in a class. 1st-10 points- 2nd 8 points - 3rd 5 points - 4th 3 points - 5th 2 points - 6th 1 point

There will be 3 points awarding shows. - 21st April 2019 – Open Spring Show

9th June 2019 – Members Only Show

11th August 2019 – Open Summer

QUALILFIER INFORMATION

TSR QUALIFYING RULES

TSR Showing Finals - This show is a qualifier for the 2019 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class. Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/

BSHA Grass Roots Championships - With a TSR qualification flyer you can also enter the BSHA Grass Roots Champs on the 9th Sept at Addington Equestrian Centre - You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final. See http://www.britishshowhorse.org

TSR Medal Awards - TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

South West Pony Association Championships Qualifying Rules

This show is a qualifier for the South West Pony Association Championships to be held on 29 August – 31 August 2019 at The David Broome Event Centre, Crick, Monmouthshire. NP26 5XP

To qualify for the Championships: 1. Enter one of the qualifying classes. 2. Be one of the two highest placed exhibits not already qualified within the first four and receive a qualification card. 3. Complete the entry form on the qualification card. 4.Register on-line at www.showingscene.com within 14 days of qualification 5. Upload this card using our on-line management system at www.showingscene.com

Please Note: Registration fee for 2019 is £30 to include all members of the family and equines owned by the family.

For shows held after the 2019 Championship Show, qualification will be for the 2020 Championship Show

VHPRC Qualifying Show Rules

- Il Horse and rider combinations may only qualify once. If we do not receive your qualifying card on time, you cannot qualify a second time.
- ii Horse and rider combinations can qualify in both ridden and in-hand classes.
- If these have already qualified, the card will be passed down to previous nonqualifiers to 6th place.
- For Mature Rider qualification first 3 qualify but if previously qualified the qualification can pass down to 6th place.
- Qualifying card must be returned within 14 days of the show. Strictly no late entries.
- All qualifying combinations will receive a certificate and rosette at the qualifying show.
- If Entry to the Championships does not require you to be a member of the club but entry fees for the Championship classes will be double that of members.
- The age category that you qualify in will not necessarily correspond with the age categories at the Championship show.

SHOW RULES & CONDITIONS

Pre-entries cheques will be cashed prior to the show.

The organizers & landowners accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury that may be sustained in connection with the show to any person, animal or property.

Judge's decision is final.

Hard hats to BSH specification to be worn at all times when mounted.

The committee reserve the rights to cancel, add to, split or alter any class they see fit/entries warrant.

It's the competitor's responsibility to present themselves at the correct times.

No refunds of entry fee unless valid by a veterinary certificate.

Objections to be made in writing within 10mins of the end of the class accompanied by £20.

All ridden horses/ponies must be 4yrs or over

No lunging in arenas

No cantering/galloping in parking area.

No mucking out horsebox or littering in parking area.

All children to be supervised at all times.

All competitors are expected to be suitably insured for all events.

Foul language and abuse to horse, human alike will not be tolerated.

Where age is mentioned proof of age may be required.

All fallers are strongly recommended to visit the medical centre

Weight limits for riders have been introduced – which means that if a judge or official steward have concerns they may ask the rider weight (or ask rider to weigh) before able to compete. The rider must not weight more than 18% of the horse's weigh.

All person attending show will deemed to have accepted these conditions.
