Team and Individual entries

Intro B (2009) – Senior and junior individual only
Team Entries – each member of the team to ride one of the following:
Prelim 2 (2016), Prelim 7 (2002), Novice 24 (2010), Novice 27 (2007).
Or Individual entries if a club is unable to field a team.

Anyone displaying any Covid 19 symptoms or who has been in contact with anyone with Covid 19 symptoms must not attend.

Only the rider plus one helper per horse may attend. Team managers may attend.
Please Arrive, Compete and Leave 😊

Eligibility is taken from the Friday before the qualifier, all those competing must be on the BRC database by the Friday before the competition.

Prelim Eligibility: Horses can have Unlimited BD Prelim points, but 0 Points at Novice or above, the horse can't have competed in elementary or above in the same competition year BD or BRC.

Riders are ineligible if they hold FBHS, BHSI, BHSII having qualified in the past 10 years, or have competed under FEI rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years. Riders can't have competed at BE Novice or Elementary Dressage or above in the current or previous calendar year BD or BRC.

Novice Eligibility: Horses can hold unlimited BD Novice points, up to 35 Elementary points, 0 points at Medium or above.

Riders are ineligible if they hold FBHS, BHSI or have competed under FEI rules in the relevant discipline in the last 5 calendar years. Riders can't have completed at BE Intermediate or Elementary dressage or above in the current or previous calendar year BD or BRC.

From 1st October, BRC are reverting back to their 6 monthly flu vaccination program. All horses attending this competition must have a correct flu vaccs history as per BRC rules including a booster within the last 6 months and 21 days of the competition date and no vaccinations within the 7 days prior to the competition.

Entry Fee: £60 per team or £15 Individuals

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Riders may wear soft face masks that cover the mouth and nose, but face shields are not permitted. Nothing is to be attached to the riding hat.
2. Anyone not complying with event protocols will be disqualified and asked to leave site immediately. There will be no exceptions to this rule. Any such instances will also be reported to BRC HQ for further disciplinary consideration if deemed appropriate.
3. Passport checks will not be done on the day due to covid , at this difficult time the onus is upon the team manager and owners to ensure the passports are correct and vaccinations are current and correct. All passports should continue to travel with the horse as it is a legal requirement.
4. Lorries/trailers should be parked 5m apart to allow for tying up on one side.
5. Riders must bring their own bridle numbers / saddle cloth numbers and the competitor numbers should be displayed on both sides of the horse.
6. ***Team managers to send declaration forms by 5pm on Saturday 5th December.***
7. There will be no scoreboards at the event. Results will be posted live www.ksec-results.co.uk
8. Team managers /Individuals to leave a large SAE with enough postage for sheets & rosettes to be posted after the event. No sheets or rosettes will be handed out on the day.
9. Warm up time is limited to 30 minutes prior to your start time. Please follow the stewards instructions at all times.
10. The warm up arena will be limited to 6 people at all times. No persons on foot will be allowed into the warmup. .
11. Please leave as soon as possible once you have competed.
12. If travelling with another competitor, please state on entry.
13. All entries must be made on the official British Riding Clubs Entry Form for the Winter Dressage Area Qualifiers. Please indicate on the Area entry form which combination is riding which dressage test.
14. Owners and riders enter at their own risk.
15. The judge's decision in relation to the competition results and that of the official steward in relation to all other matters will be final.
16. This competition will run under British Riding Club Rules 2020.
17. Dressage tests at Area Qualifiers may be commanded.
18. In the event of withdrawals, the organisers regret that they cannot refund entry fees after the close of prelim entries.
19. Balloting may take place if excessive entries. We shall prioritize Q team entries and do our best to accommodate as many individuals as possible – arena and time allowing.
20. All horses and or ponies must be 4yrs or over.
21. **DO NOT skip lorries out into the car park and please pick up all of your horses dropping, no haynets outside trailers / lorries please.**
22. Competitors must wear the correct hats, dress and footwear:
Hard hats must be worn and chin strap fastened by all riders when mounted, conforming to PAS015 (1998 or 2011) or BSEN 1384 (1997) or EN1384 (1996) and must be BSI Kitemark. Plus ASTM F1163 (2004) and must be SEI Mark

or Snell E2001 and must have Official SNELL label and number or AS/NZS 3838 (2003 or 2006) and must have SAI Global Mark. All competitors competing in Area 9 Qualifying classes must have a BRC Official hat tag. Failure to do so will result in elimination.

23. **Health and Safety** - The Organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and Officials and Stewards.
24. **Legal Liability** - Horse / pony sports can be dangerous, and animals are unpredictable. Neither the Warman Family, Kings Sedgemoor equestrian nor any person acting on their behalf, or the landowners can accept any liability for the loss, damage, accident or injury to any person or property. It is a condition of entry that each entrant agrees to indemnify the above persons against any legal action arising from such an incident.

All persons attending the show will be deemed to have accepted these rules and conditions.
